### BIBLICAL STUDIES (BS)

Course Titles and Descriptions	Instructors
<b>BS 101 “The Greatest Story Ever Told”</b>	<b>Min. LaWanza Spears</b>
This course is to consider the theological messages that result from a dialogue between film and biblical narrative.	<i>MPBC</i>
<b>BS 102 “Esther”</b>	<b>Rev. Khalfani Drummer</b>

<b>ET 101 “Revolutionary Religion”</b>	<b>Rev. Joseph Evans</b>

<b>ET 102 “Web-Casting”</b>	<b>Rev. Marquez Ball</b>

<b>DS 101 “Se7en”</b>	<b>Rev. Sylvia Ball</b>
The study explores classic “7 deadly sins” (lust, gluttony, greed, sloth, wrath, envy and pride) and the dynamics of shame, guilt, and forgiveness from theological and social-psychological perspectives. <b>DS 102 “The Perfect 10”</b>	<b>Rev. Geraldine Tompkins</b>

<b>CE 101 “The Blessing &amp; Burden of Being Baptist”</b>	<b>Rev. John Rhodes</b>

<b>CE 102 “2012”</b>	<b>Rev. Eric Redmond</b>
With so much talk of the end of the world being near in movies and myths, when will the world really end? <b>SW 101 “Psalms and Negro Spirituals”</b>	<b>Rev. Larry McCray</b>

<b>SW 102 “Angels: Elect and Evil”</b>	<b>Rev. David McIntosh-Peters</b>

<b>CS 101 “KidZone” (ages 3-8)</b>	<b>Deaconess Elizabeth Williams</b>
